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2023 Accomplishments

Innovation and Developments

- Added 3 more participants to the Valley Guardians and Challenge Foundation college scholarship. That brings the total # of college scholarships to 8.
- Analysis of our Valley Guardians coaching program scholarship revealed 20 students have graduated in last three years [14 are in college, and 3 are employed].
- Started new private school for 5-8th grades during Fall 2023.
- Found 2 new partners.
- Partnered with the Gila River Indian Community. They wanted to find a program that was flexible for parents and students' summer schedules and provided quality leadership education.
- Partnered with Chandler School District Migrant program to support their students in our leadership programs.
- Both partners were very satisfied and will continue their relationship with LSA.
- Donated Thanksgiving meals to 9 families totaling over \$1.5K.
- Added more engaging videos on our YouTube Channel.


