International Resilient Leader Scholarship Overview

The International Resilient Leader Scholarship is a merit-based grant awarded to exceptional students who have demonstrated excellence in academics, extracurricular activities, leadership, and community service. This scholarship is open to F1 visa students currently enrolled in an accredited college degree program in Maricopa County, Arizona. An International Resilient Leader is someone who has achieved significant personal growth despite overwhelming adversity. They are individuals who continuously strive to improve themselves, even when faced with challenges uncommon for their age. The most impactful leaders are not defined by their titles, income, or accomplishments but by their commitment to self-betterment and their desire to contribute meaningfully to society. The International Resilient Leader Scholarship provides recipients with both financial support and mentorship, tailored to help them succeed. This is a grant-based scholarship, not a work or service-based award. Recipients are not required to complete community service, volunteer hours, or any form of work for Leadership Society of Arizona (LSA) or any of its entities in exchange for the scholarship. Scholarship funds may be used for both educational and non-educational expenses, with financial need considered in determining the amount awarded. As a merit-based program, this scholarship is open to all who meet the eligibility requirements. Winners are selected based on their demonstrated commitment to personal growth and their potential to make a positive impact on society.

Award: up to \$20,000 per year

Eligibility Requirements:

- Students must be an F1 visa student.
- Students must be motivated towards self-improvement.
- Have faced significant challenges in their lives and overcame them.
- Have a 3.0 college GPA.
- Been accepted in a course of study towards a degree at an accredited four-year U.S. college/university in Maricopa County Arizona.
- Have volunteer experience (preference will be given to students who have volunteered numerous hours in a leadership or
- mentoring role and are active).
 Should express a desire to mentor others
- Should express a desire to mentor others.Submit the following four components to Team@LeadAZ.org:
 - a. Completed application form
 - b. A PowerPoint presentation about you and your life plan
 - c. Cover Letter, Resume, Professional Photo
 - d. Two Letters of Recommendation

Application Process:

- Once the application is completed, please submit to <u>Team@LeadAZ.org</u> for evaluation by the Selection Committee.
- If the requirements are met in full, a Selection Committee member will conduct a virtual interview with the applicant.
- Once the Selection Committee member completes their interview and evaluation, they will submit to the full Selection Committee for approval. If the Selection Committee feels more information is needed, they can opt to have the applicant present their PowerPoint presentation about their life and take part in a strategy session with the selection committee to discuss how the scholarship funds might be used to best benefit the applicant.
- If accepted, the applicant will be notified of scholarship and awarded funds.
